MULTI-JOURNEY TICKETS

You will find a control header portion attached to your tickets. This is for security and the tickets are only valid while they are attached to this portion. When travelling you should present the entire book with the control portion to the ticket collecting staff who will detach the ticket from your book. Individual tickets separated from the book are not valid and you may be refused travel.

Multi-journey Tickets are valid for one passenger or one nominated motorised vehicle.

Tickets are not transferable. Multi-journey tickets are for the use of one passenger only. One book of tickets cannot be used by passengers travelling in groups.

5/6/10/30/50 Journey tickets are valid for 12 months from date of issue.

Multi-journey tickets are not available on all routes. Ticket quantities are route specific. Tickets are non-refundable. Terms and conditions can be found in our timetables and brochures. Restrictions apply.

DEFACED OR DAMAGED TICKETS

Any ticket which has become illegible, mutilated or destroyed will not be valid or eligible for refund. Tickets must be kept away from water and heat sources to prevent damage.

RECEIPTS

Passengers should note that receipts can only be issued at time of ticket purchase.

CONDITIONS OF ISSUE OF TICKETS

Any ticket issued by Caledonian MacBrayne, or any other body, company or person upon whose property or premises the ticket may be available, is subject to the Regulations and Conditions of Carriage published by Caledonian MacBrayne.

It is the passenger's responsibility to ensure appropriate travel insurance cover.

All tickets must be purchased prior to boarding ships on any route where there is a shore ticketing facility.
